There are times when people who live with disabilities or long-term struggles feel like no one really understands what they’re going through. Some students feel this way too—like their pain, stress, or challenges are invisible to everyone else. But the Bible reminds us that Jesus understands more deeply than anyone.

Isaiah calls Jesus “a man of sorrows.” That means He lived with sadness and heavy burdens throughout His whole life on earth. He knew what it felt like to be rejected, misunderstood, and overlooked. Hebrews even says that Jesus prayed with “fervent cries and tears.” He carried the weight of the cross long before He ever got there.

So when you feel discouraged, stressed, or alone, you're not talking to a distant God. You're talking to Someone who has felt real pain, real pressure, and real grief. Jesus understands disability, struggle, and the weight of things you don't always know how to explain. You can open your heart to Him completely.



Dear Lord, thank You for understanding my struggles and my pain. Thank You for carrying sorrow and suffering so You could be close to me. Help me trust You today, and be my Shelter when life feels heavy. Amen.
